Other Services.

Frenulotomy.

Tongue-tie (ankyloglossia) is a condition in which the thin piece of skin under the baby's tongue (the lingual frenulum) is abnormally short or tight which may restrict the movement of the tongue .



This can cause problems with your baby's feeding. I offer a prompt home visit to release the tongue tie (frenulotomy)

and to support your ongoing breastfeeding.

Massage Matters.

In September 2007, under the direction of Peter Walker, I qualified as a Teacher of Developmental Baby Massage and Movement.

These techniques offer benefits for relaxation, digestion, breathing and development, all of which complement my breastfeeding support.
